This sermon will be preached before the committee and you will then be assessed based on this material and the following:
- 2. A statement of faith

It is recommended that this simple outline for a one-page Statement of Faith be used by potential members of POV.

- a. What is your understanding of God?
- b. What is your understanding of Jesus?
- c. What is your understanding of the Holy Spirit?
- d. What is your understanding of the Trinity?
- e. What is your understanding of Scripture?
- f. What is your understanding of the nature and role of the Church and the Sacraments?
- g. What is your understanding of Christian Discipleship?
- 3. A faith journey statement
- 4. Understanding and incorporation of the reformed tradition in your own theology of life and practice (be prepared to speak about theologians)
- 5. Understanding of the confessions and your use of them in life and practice
- 6. Understanding of the meaning of the questions required for ordination
- 7. Demonstrate a commitment to the ministry of Teaching Elder within the discipline of the PCUSA with personal maturity, spiritual depth, and a capacity to respond to the needs of others including colleagues in ministry.
- 8. Understanding of the questions for ordination and an ability to articulate the meaning of each question for you as it applies to ministry in the PCUSA.
